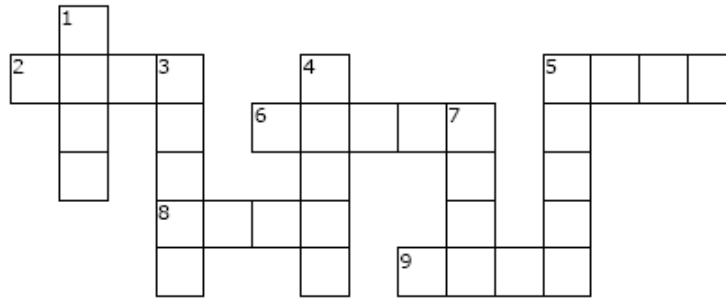


# Crossword Puzzle

### ***10th Sunday after Pentecost***

Hello friends! I love a good rainstorm. One of my favorite things to do, since I was little, is to go out on the front porch and watch the rain. I love the way it sounds, the way it smells, the way it feels. Now a rainstorm is very different from a hurricane. Those can be kind of scary and do quite a bit of damage. It's really not very smart to be outside in those! Can you imagine being on a boat during a hurricane?!

Our Gospel lesson from Matthew tells us a story of Jesus' friend, Peter on a boat...during a very BIG windstorm!! Do you think Peter was scared? You bet he was! Jesus had sent the disciples out in the boat while he went up the mountain to pray. When morning came, Jesus walked **on** the sea towards the boat and this frightened the disciples as they did not know it was Jesus until he spoke to them. Jesus told his friends not to be afraid, it's me, not a ghost! Jesus called to his friend Peter to walk towards him **on** the water,, but a strong wind came up behind Peter and he began to sink because he doubted what Jesus had called him to do. Jesus caught him and then calmed the wind. How cool is that! Walking on water and calming the wind?!
