Transfiguration Sunday

Jesus took Peter, John, and James and went up on a mountain to pray. As Jesus was praying, his face was changed and his clothes became a dazzling white.

Suddenly, two men appeared and began talking to Jesus. Do you know who it was? It Moses and Elijah. What a glorious sight! As Moses and Elijah started to leave, Peter said to Jesus. "Master, it is wonderful for us to be here! Let's build three shelters -- one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah."

Suddenly, a cloud appeared and covered them. A voice came from the cloud saying, "This is my Son, listen to him." When the voice had spoken, Moses and Elijah were gone and the disciples were once again alone with Jesus on the mountain. What an experience! You and I have many wonderful experiences as we follow Jesus. When we have a great "mountain top experience" we may wish that it would never end. But remember, every day that we follow Jesus is a wonderful blessing!
