Seventh Sunday of Easter


Acts 1:15-17, 21-26 Psalm 4 1 John 5:9-13 John 17:6-19

Good morning friends! Can anyone tell me what prayer is? Prayer is talking to God. When do you pray? You can pray anytime...and anywhere! Prayer is an ongoing conversation. Do you know that we don't even have to use words when we talk to God? God knows our heart before we even mention a word to God but it sure helps to say it out loud. Do we have to pray a certain way, like with our eyes closed and our heads bowed? Nope! We can pray however we feel like it, whether we are running and jumping, riding in a car, or sitting quietly. No matter where, when, or how, God always hears us and takes time to listen.

In our Gospel lesson from John, we hear the story about Jesus getting ready to leave his disciples to be with God, and guess what? Jesus prays! Jesus prays for his friends and in this prayer, he prays for you, too! Jesus asks God to protect all of us and to unify us so that we can be one big family.
