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**AWARENESS
SESSIONS:**

Care of Creation: We have come so far, but we have so far to go.

Jody Smiley, retired analytical environmental chemist, will take us on a journey through years of how we impacted God's creation, both bad and good. In the discussion of climate, we often only hear about our negative impacts on the environment, but Jody hopes to share with us some ways science and technology have counteracted those negative impacts. She will also discuss how future advancements by engineers and scientist will make them "Guardians of Creation".

What Can I Do?

In this session, you will learn ways you can make a meaningful impact on our environment - big or small. You will hear about and discuss ideas from small everyday actions to bigger lifestyle choices you can make.

Want to do more? We will talk about ways you can advocate and even volunteer for the cause. You will leave the session with realistic, doable ideas to help be a better Guardian of our Creation!

Mended Women

Mended Women Lifestyle Recovery is a 70-bed residential recovery program for women in Abingdon. It is the only facility of its kind in southwestern Virginia serving a 150-mile radius. Residents graduate from the program better equipped to navigate successfully lifelong recovery with the skills and healing necessary to reclaim a life of purpose and joy. The 2026 service project will benefit Mended Women.

Article VI, Section 2: Representation Item 1: Voting members of a convention shall be the elected officers or SWO leaders and board members of the synodical women's organization and one voting member from each unit on the roll of this synodical women's organization. *Item 2:* Those congregations not represented by a unit shall be invited to send to the regular convention one representative who shall have seat and voice.
