

- 1. If this story happened today, what would it look like?
- 2. What does this story say to you?
- 3. How could this story make a difference in my life?

- Begin eating
- Create space for a Jesus story, ask one of the sharing simple questions to create discussion, include prayer with thanksgiving for the meal
